- b** All Teutonic **Kn** are -1 in close combat versus light enemy from their 6th bound onwards.
- c** The **Knechts** should be assigned to protect the camp.
  
- d** **Vytautas** is a Brilliant General
- e** **Jagiello** will not advance further than the rearmost element in his Command.
- f** Treat **Tartar** LH as being one morale level **worse** than other elements in command
- g** The **Smolensk** contingent fight as Kn(O) in their bound and Kn(S) in the enemy bound
