Any prospective wargamers in the area who contact us either via the club website or who see us at shows will be placed on a strictly confidential database. This database may be accessed from our website (www.kirkleescrusaders.co.uk/TCSData).

Persons wishing to be included on the database should leave the following information with us: Your Name, email address (see later), telephone number (optional), district/Town of residence and a list of your interests (include period [be as specific as possible], scale, armies owned, rules system used and any other relevant information).

Note: The email address and telephone numbers would not appear on the publicly accessible database.

If you wish to get in contact with another gamer on the database please contact a Kirklees Crusader (preferably ianwhite63@yahoo.co.uk) in the first instance, leaving your own details (e-mail/phone at least - and what you want to contact them about). We will then advise the person of your request and then it will be up to them to contact you to arrange for a game.
